First race – Sunday 30 October 22

Last race – Wednesday 29<sup>th</sup> March 2023

Extra Easter series – Sunday 2<sup>nd</sup> April 2023 to Sunday 30<sup>th</sup> April 2023

Christmas / New year Break – 20<sup>th</sup> December 21 to 1<sup>st</sup> January 22

Twilight series – 20 races, Wednesday Evenings, 6:00 pm Div 2 start, 6:05 pm Div 1 start (Early start for last 2 races).

Division 3 (Green Fleet) may start after or with Division 1

Green Fleet – Regular sail training on Sunday mornings

Point-score series – 12 races, Sunday afternoons, 3pm start

Trophy races – 5 race days, Sunday afternoons, 1pm start – two races back-to-back

Easter / Autumn series – 4 Sundays during April 2023

Note – If races are abandoned during a series, replacement races will be scheduled the following week(s), if possible, until caught up.

Wallagoot Lake Boat Club Regatta, 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> March 2023 – no races at LJSC

Marathon, Sunday 29<sup>th</sup> January 2023, 1pm start (12:15pm briefing)

Stern Chaser, Sunday 26<sup>th</sup> February 2023, 3pm start (2:15pm briefing)

### **Scoring**

Twilight series – 20 races - 6 worst scores to be dropped = 14 scored races to count (drops may be reduced if races are abandoned and not caught up)

Point-score series – 12 races - 4 worst scores to be dropped = 8 scored races to count (drops may be reduced if races are abandoned and not caught up)

Trophy series – 10 races - 3 worst scores to be dropped = 7 scored races to count (drops may be reduced if races are abandoned and not caught up)

Easter / Autumn series – 4 races – 1 worst race to be dropped = 3 scored races to count (drop may be reduced if races are abandoned and not caught up)

### **Scoring Codes**

Race score = corrected time place achieved in each race

Twilight series races' elapsed times to be corrected by each competitor's individual Handicap

Sunday series races' elapsed times to be corrected by each boat class' Australian sailing Yardstick

Rescue Boat Duty (RBD) - Div 1 = 4, Div 2 = 3 - Note – only those rostered for duty earn points.

Did Not compete (DNC) = Fleet for whole series +1 (will be worst score of the series)

Did Not Finish (DNF) = Fleet for the race + 1

Did Not Start (DNS) = Fleet for the race + 1 – Note – only applied if a sailor misses the start due to a mishap on the way to the start line or doesn't start within the time limit

Other Club Regatta (OCR) representing LJSC at an away regatta - Div 1 = 4, Div 2 = 3

Black Flag Disqualification (BFD) = Fleet for the race + 1

### **Handicapping System**

Refer to the Results page of the LJSC website (<http://lakejindabyneclub.com/results.php>) to find a document which details how the club's Handicapping System works.

Competitors' Handicaps are adjusted each week during the season according to their corrected time results in each race to spread the results among all of the competitors.

Handicap adjustments are determined by each sailor's results. The adjustments are applied to each sailor's handicap ready to be used in the next race. A sailor's first handicap is their class of boat's Australian Sailing Yardstick.

The adjustments are a percentage of each boat Class' Yardstick according to the table below.

	<b>Div 1 – Monohulls</b>	<b>Div 2 - Catamarans</b>
1 <sup>st</sup>	-3.0% reduction	-2.0% reduction
2 <sup>nd</sup>	-2.0% reduction	-1.0% reduction
3 <sup>rd</sup>	-1.0% reduction	No change
4 <sup>th</sup>	No change	+1.0% increase
5 <sup>th</sup>	+1.0% increase	+1.5% increase
6 <sup>th</sup>	+1.5% increase	+2.0% increase
7 <sup>th</sup>	+2.0% increase	+2.5% increase
8 <sup>th</sup>	+2.5% increase	+3.0% increase
9 <sup>th</sup>	+3.0% increase	+3.5% increase
10 <sup>th</sup> or greater	+4.0% increase	+4.0% increase

Note – Sailors have to compete in the races to adjust their handicaps as only achieved race scores receive the above adjustments.

RBD, DNC, DNF, DNS, OCR and BFD all receive no handicap adjustment

Competitors' 2022-23 sailing season Handicaps will be based on the 2021-22 handicaps achieved after 20 twilight races.

The Division 1 handicaps have been reduced by a factor of 4% for sailors who participated in 10 or greater races during 2021-22

The 2021-22 handicaps for sailors who competed in less than 10 races have not been adjusted

The Division 2 handicaps will be sailors' handicaps as at the end of the 2021-22 season.

Sailors who change their class of boat at the start of the season or during the season will receive their boat class' Australian Sailing Yardstick which will then change according to the above progressions.
