Item #3. Business Arising (raised by Ross Lawley)

- 1. **Update on Licence/Lease** Ross Lawley advised that the proposal for a 10 year with two 5 year options has been submitted to Snowy Monaro Regional Council and is being considered by them at the meeting on the 15th October 2020. Phil Daley has offered to attend and make a presentation to Council on the Club's behalf. Memebers of the Committee have personally contacted most of the Councilors and have received positive feedback on our proposal.
 - 2. Update on Boat Sheds Barney advised that the Grant Funding Deed was executed at the end of August and our first

progress payment received. Thanks to a great turnout on Saturday the 3rd October the old shed was completely dismantled and removed off site except for some frames which will be removed shortly. The trees have been cut down and earthworks will start in the next week. The sheds have ben ordered from Jindy SteelWorx with delivery expected around mid November.

Item #4. General Business (raised by Alan Davis)

- 1. **Fees** To remain the same as last season. Invoices have already been sent. It should be noted that unless fees are paid you or your crew cannot compete in any sailing events. The Sail Pass is operating for any casual sailors. Nick asked if external hire fees need to be adjusted for COVID restrictions and if they should be compared to other community venues around town. Tim noted that fees are in line with what Council allows us to charge sub-licencees. Fees for boat storage may also need to be reviewed when the new shed is built.
- 2. **Shed Storage** Nick Kennedy asked what are the plans for the storage layout in the new sheds. No firm plans at this stage and any suggestions on different methods are welcome.
- 3. **Regatta 2020** to be held on the 4/5/6 December 2020. Steve advised that he has applied for a liquor licence exemption for Saturday and Sunday afternoons. Nick and Ian have offered equipment for sterilising the club at the end of each day. Taipans have confirmed that they are attending and Barney noted that some Nacra's may be coming.
- 4. **Junior Committee** Alistair proposed that we form a Junior Committee to provide a more balanced view of decisions for the Club. Some of the young adults who might be prepared to nominate are Lucy and Alexi Cross, Hayden and Freya Slater and Sam Bylett. This will be discussed at the next Committee Meeting.
- 5. **Treasurer** Adam wanted to thank Tim for his work as Treasurer and this was overwhelmingly supported by the meeting. Thanks Tim.
- 6. **Working Bee** To be held on Saturday 17th October starting at 10.00 am. The race shed needs to be emptied and furniture set up in the clubhouse.
- 7. **Presentation of Trophies from 2019/20** These are in stock and will be handed out in November at a barbecue following sailing when we start getting numbers back sailing.
 - 8. RHIB Trailer Kerry advised that this trailer needs a full refurbishment before it can be registered.

Item #5. Training Courses (raised by Alistair Cross)

A qualified instructor (Jemma) will be available to provide training this year in addition to the club's already qualified instructors. It is planned to run Tackers 1, 2, 3 and Dinghy Courses early this season. Arrangements will also be made for Adult and Female participation as well. Out There Sailing will also be offered, possibly on the same days as the training.
