The meeting commenced at 4.35pm.

It was resolved that JBa will compile the Notice Of Race (NOR) and distribute it to the Committee members for perusal prior to it being despatched.

The meeting would like to see the Notice distributed as soon as possible and as far and wide as possible.

JBy to post NOR on web page and set up an email address for enquiries. Email enquiries will initially be received by JBy who will redirect them to the relevant Committee member.

It was suggested that a FAQ page could be added to the Regatta web page with answers to frequently asked questions such as where to stay, where to eat out, cost, how to register, any other FAQs???

JA reported that the catering for Saturday and Sunday is arranged. JA will do the Friday night meal. It was decided that the cost for that meal will be \$20 per head.

AD reported that he had approached Jindabyne Brewery regarding sponsorship and they are interested. Is yet to chat to Marty from Sacred Ride. He will also approach ESS. The meeting felt that the sponsorship we are looking for is NOT to cover the naming rights of the entire regatta but rather for specific races or maybe for one of the days. Also, sponsorship/prizes need to be relevant, that is, not much use a sailor from Canberra winning a gift voucher for a store in Jindabyne.

JA will look into what sort of sponsorship/prizes options other clubs use in their events.

Need to ensure that participants know that they will need to provide proof of insurance when entering the regatta. Maybe someone will need to be allocated to check this.

AC reported that he did not think having the Learn To Sail juniors being part of the regatta was a good idea. Maybe a casual "something" on one of the mornings (Saturday?) for them.
